THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE ANCIENT WORLD

Symphonie nr. 1 – Alex Poelman

In de Oudheid werden de zeven toonaangevende mooiste monumenten "De Zeven Wereldwonderen" genoemd. In zijn eerste symfonie "The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World" schildert de Nederlandse componist Alex Poelman een muzikaal portret van deze zeven "wonderen". De symfonie is magistraal en rijkelijk geoorkestreerd en beeldt zowel de kracht die de grote rijken van de Oudheid uitstraalden als de pracht van de meestige gebouwen en kunstwerken uit, terwijl de verleidelijke Oosterse charme en de geheimzinnige exotische sfeer evenmin ontbreken.

Alex Poelman (Arnhem, 1981) studeerde informatica aan de Universiteit Twente en speelt hoor in diverse harmonieorkesten. Onder begeleiding van David Rowland schreef hij zijn eerste compositie voor harmonieorkest "Volcano". Na zijn eerste werk voor harmonieorkest volgden: "Theseus", "Symphony 1: The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World", "D-Day" en "Aquila Chrysatoo". Op 28 mei 2004 ging zijn 1ste symfonie in première in het muziekcentrum van Enschede. Een jaar later werd deze symfonie door de KMKJWF (Koninklijke Militaire Kapel Johan Willem Friso) onder de leiding van Norbert Nozy op CD gezet.

V. DE HANGENDE TUINEN VAN BABYLON
Babylon, een stad aan de oevers van de Eufraat in het oude Mesopotamië, kende haar grote bloei onder het bewind van koning Nabuchodonosor II (6de eeuw v.Chr.). De geschiedschrijver Herodotus (ca 484-425 v.Chr.) beschreef de pracht van deze stad met o.m. de beroverde Poort van Ishtar en de sprookjesachtige "hangende tuinen" die vaak aan de legendarische koningin van Assyrië en Babylon, Semiramis werden toegeschreven.

VI. DE VUURTOREN VAN ALEXANDRIË
Het eiland Pharos in de buurt van de Egyptische stad Alexandrië aan de monding van de Nijl werd in 285 v.Chr. door een dam met de stad verbonden en Sostratus van Knidos bouwde er een witte marmeren toren van 180 m hoog waarop's nachts vuren brandden om de scheepen de weg te wijzen. De toren werd in 1302 over een aardbeving verwoest.

VII. DE KOLOS VAN RHODES
In de 3de eeuw v.Chr. kende de havenstad Rhodos op het gelijknamige Griekse eiland een grote bloei. Na een grote overwinning werd in 280 v.Chr. in de haven een reusachtig bronzen beeld van de zonnegod Helios geplaatst. Het was verbaasd door de beeldhouwer Hagesander, en 35 m hoog, zodat de scheepen onder de been van het beeld door de haven in en uit vaarden. In deel werd in 224 v.Chr. door een aardbeving verwoest.
Met deze prachtige originele symfonie schreef Alex Poelman ongetwijfeld een erg waardevol nieuw concertwerk voor groot harmonieorkest.

THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE ANCIENT WORLD LES SEPT MERVEILLES DU MONDE

Symphonie Nr. 1 – Alex Poelman

Dans l'Antiquité on qualifiait les sept plus beaux monuments du monde de "Les Sept merveilles du Monde". Dans sa première symphonie "The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World" (les sept merveilles du monde antique) le jeune compositeur néerlandais Alex Poelman esquisse un portrait musical de ces sept splendides réalisations humaines toutes disparues de nos jours à une exception près. La symphonie est magistralement et richement orchestrée et dépeint aussi bien la puissance des grands souverains de l'Antiquité que la splendeur des sites baroques et exotiques d'un monde antique. On y trouve également le charme oriental séduisant et l'atmosphère exotique mystérieuse des sites.

Alex Poelman (Arnhem, 1981) a étudié l'informatique à l'Université de Twente et il joue le cor d'harmonie dans plusieurs sociétés d'amateurs. Il a écrit sa première composition pour orchestre à vents « Volcano » avec l'assistance de David Rowland. Cette composition a été suivie de « Theseus », sa première Symphonie nr. 1 « Les Sept Merveilles du Monde », « D-Day » et « Aquila Chrysatoo ». Sa première symphonie a été créée le 28 mai 2004 à Enschede. Un an plus tard, elle a été enregistrée sur CD par le nouvel orchestre militaire KMKJWF sous la direction de Norbert Nozy.

V. LES JARDINS SUSPENDUS DE BABYLONE

Babylone (Babylonië), une ville située sur les rives de l'Euphrate dans l'ancienne Mésopotamie, connut son apogée sous le règne du roi Nabuchodonosor II (6ème siècle av. J.-C.). L'historien grec Hérodote (vers 484-425 av. J.-C.) a été le premier à décrire ces jardins, entre autres, la célèbre Porte d'Ishtar et les féroces "jardins suspendus" souvent attribués à Semiramis, la reine légendaire d'Assyrie et de Babylone.

VI. LE PHARE D'ALEXANDRIE

En 285 av. J.-C., Ptolémée II fit relier l'île de Pharos, tout près de la ville égyptienne d'Alexandria, au continent par un mur de 1300 m. et y fit construire par Sostrate de Crète une tour de marbre blanche de 180 m. de hauteur, surmontée d'un phare, qui entrait dans le port et qui éclairait la nuit le passage de la mer Méditerranée. Le phare fut détruit par un tremblement de terre en 224 av. J.-C.

VI. LE COLOSSE DE RHODES

La ville portuaire de Rhodes sur l'île grecque du même nom connaît son apogée sous le règne de l'empereur Séleucus II Philopator (187-145 av. J.-C.). Il fait ériger un colosse en bronze de 32 mètres de haut contre l'empereur Ptolémée III Philopator (142-117 av. J.-C.). L'architecte Hippodame de Rhodes a conçu un plan urbain en permettant aux navires de passer en dessous pour entrer et quitter le port. Le colosse fut détruit par un tremblement de terre en 224 av. J.-C.

Avec cette magnifique symphonie originale, Alex Poelman a certainement engagé le répertoire symphonique mondial.

THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE ANCIENT WORLD

Symphony nr.1 – Alex Poelman

In the Ancient World the seven most beautiful monuments were called "The Seven Wonders of the World". In his Symphony nr.1, The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, the young Dutch composer Alex Poelman has made a musical portrait of these splendid human realizations which are still there for us all to destroy. The symphony is masterly and lavishly orchestrated and portrays both the power of the sovereigns of ancient times and the splendor of the most beautiful buildings and works of art they have had built. Moreover, neither the seducing Eastern charm nor the mysterious exotic atmosphere are fading.

Alex Poelman (Arnhem, 1981) studied informatics at the Twente University and plays French horn in several top amateur bands. Under the guidance of David Rowland he wrote his first composition for wind band "Volcano". This was followed by "Theseus", "Symphony nr. 1 "The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World", "D-Day" and "Aquila Chrysaetos". This symphony was premiered on 28 May 2004 at Enschede. One year later, it was recorded on CD by the new Dutch metal band KMKWF conducted by Norbert Nozy.

V. THE HANGING GARDENS OF BABYLON

Babylon, a city on the banks of the river Euphrates in ancient Mesopotamia was flourishing under the reign of King Nabuchodonosor II (6th century B.C.). The Greek historian Herodotus (ca 484-425 B.C.) described the splendour and luxury of this city, with others, the famous Ishtar Gate and the fabulous "hanging gardens" often attributed to Semiramis, the legendary queen of Assyria and Babylon.

VI. THE LIGHTHOUSE OF ALEXANDRIA

The isle of Pharos, near the Egyptian city of Alexandria on the Nile delta, was linked to the continent by a 13000 m long mole in 285 B.C. Sostratus of Knidos built a 180 m high white marble tower on it. On top of the tower two fires were kept burning at night, in order to guide the ships. It was destroyed by an earth quake in 248 B.C.

With this beautiful original symphony, Alex Poelman has, no doubt, enriched the better concert repertoire for symphonic band.

THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE ANCIENT WORLD DIE SIEBEN WELTWUNDER

Symphony Nr.1 – Alex Poelman

In Klassischen Altertum wurden die sieben schönsten Denkmäler „Die sieben Weltwunder“ genannt. In seiner ersten Sinfonie für Sinfonisches Blasorchester „The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World“ schildert der junge niederländische Komponist Alex Poelman ein musikalisches Porträt von diesen sieben prächtigen menschlichen Realisierungen die alle, bis auf eine, zerstört wurden und verschwunden sind. Alex Poelman (Arnhem, 1981) studierte Informatik an der Universität von Twente und spielt Waldhorn in verschiedenen Amateurorchestern. Unter der Begleitung von David Rowland schrieb er seine erste Komposition für Blasorchester „Volcano“. Nachher folgten „Theseus“, „Symphony Nr.1: The Seven Wonders of the Ancient World“, „D-Day“ und „Aquila Chrysaetos“. Am 28. Mai 2004 wurde diese Sinfonie in Enschede uraufgeführt. Ein Jahr später, wurde sie vom neuen niederländischen Militärorchester KMKWF, unter der Leitung von Norbert Nozy, auf CD eingespielt. Die Sinfonie ist meisterhaft und ganz farbenreich orchestriert und bildet nicht nur die große Macht der Herrscher der Antike aus, sondern auch die Pracht der schönsten Gebäude und Kunstwerke dieser Epoche. Ebenso wie die verführernde orientalische Charme und die geheimnisvolle exotische Atmosphäre.

V. DIE HÄNGENDEN GÄRTEN VON BABYLON

Babylon, eine Stadt am Ufer des Euphrats im antiken Mesopotamien, kannte eine große Blüte unter der Verwaltung vom König Nabuchodonosor II (im 6. Jahrhundert vor Christo). Der griechische Historiker Herodot (ca 484-425 vor Christo) beschreibt die Pracht dieser Stadt mit, unter anderen, dem berühmten Tor von Ishtar und den „hängenden Gärten“ die oft Semiramis, der legendären Königin von Assyrien und Babylon zugeschrieben werden.

VI. DER LEUCHTTURM VON ALEXANDRIE

Die Insel Pharos in der Nähe der ägyptischen Stadt Alexandria im Nildelta wurde 285 v.Chr. durch einen 1300 Meter lange Mole mit dem Festland verbunden. Sostratos von Knidos baute darauf einen Turm von weißem Marmor der 180 Meter hoch war. Nachts brannten auf diesem Turm zwei Feuer um die Schiffe zu führen. Der Turm wurde 1303 von einem Erdbeben zerstört.

VII. DER KOLOSS VON RHODOS

Im Jahr 280 v.Chr. wurde auf der Hafenstadt Rhodos auf dem gleichnamigen Berg Icaria der berühmte Koloss gebaut. Über dem Kopf des Demetrios Proroktes wurde 280 vor Christo im Hafen eine riesige Bronzestatue errichtet, die vom Bildhauer Khares geschaffen wurde und von 35 Metern Höhe, so konnten die Segel der Schiffe leichter den Wind segeln. Das Riesenbild wurde 224 vor Christo von einem Erdbeben zerstört. Mit dieser prachtvollen originären Sinfonie hat Alex Poelman bestimmt das Thema des Seven Wonders of the Ancient World bereichert.
