

What does our "flexible winds series" consist of? This flyer contains works ranging from 3 to 8 voices (recognizable by the icon). Within this number of voices, we have created a balanced arrangement of all instruments found in a wind band and fanfare band (in most cases also Brass band). This allows you to generate a complete sound with each instrumentation, even if your ensemble is not complete.
