1. If bar 133-134 is too high for first trumpet please change all trumpet parts in this way:

2. In order to add more spectacularity, in "S" Maestoso, you can add typical military percussion, for example, Military Drums, Tenor Drums, Bass Drums, like in a parade (Extra percussion part). I recommend you to be creative and use these instruments in the boxes on both sides, or in the audience. If you are still hungry, and you have the necessary resources, you can also add horns located in the audience to achieve a spectacular effect. It will be a triumphant way to finish a great concert!

## JOSÉ ALBERTO PINA.

José Alberto Pina is a Spanish reference in the world of band composition and conducting. He studied conducting at the Conservatory of Music of Murcia, also getting lessons with teachers like José Rafael Pascual-Villalpiana, Sir Colin Davis (London Symphony Orchestra), Enrique García Asensio, Jerzy Salwarsky, John Phillips (King's College London), Jan Van der Roost, Jan Cober, Paolo Bellomia (Université de Montréal) Thomas Verrier, Lutz Köhler (Universität der Künste, UDK, Berlin), etc.

He is winner of the Orchestral Conducting Competition "Ciudad de San Vicente del Raspeig" and the First National Wind Band Conducting Contest "Ciudad de Puerto Llano". He gets the 1st prize in the composition competition for band in La Font de la Figuera and he is awarded at the Second Latin American Band Composition Competition "Vila de Ortigueira" with the work "The Bermuda Triangle". He has been nominated for the Hollywood Music in Media Awards for the work The Island of Light.

José Alberto Pina conducts some professional and amateur wind orchestras like Banda Municipal de Santiago de Compostela, Banda Municipal de Palma de Mallorca, Gran Canaria Wind Orchestra, Noord Nederlands Jeugd Orkest, Sociedade de Instrução e Recreio de Paços da Serra Portugal, Orquestra de Sopros da Escola Profissional de Música de Viana do Castelo, Academia d'Artes de Cinfaes, Südbaden Winds, Sinfonisches Blasorchester Freiburg, Musikverein Stadtkapelle Bretten e.V., Pihlaih Orkester Krško, Complesso Strumentale a fiati Amilcare Ponchielli, Sinfonisches Blasorchester Freiburg, la Bläserphilharmonie Thum, etc...

Develops his activity as a composer at Molena Edition with which recorded several CDs. His commitment to the band world has taken him to be jury in competitions, performing lectures, courses and MasterClass in conducting and composition with renowned bands in Spain, Holland, Belgium, Germany, United Kingdom, Slovenia, Switzerland, Italy, Portugal, Brazil, China, Japan and Argentina.

Dunkirk is a French city that served as a backdrop for the Allied military operation between May and June 1940. Known as Operation Dynamo, it consisted of the evacuation of Allied troops that had been encircled by the Nazi German army during the Battle of Dunkirk in full invasion of France. Almost the entire British Expeditionary Force, part of the Belgian army and three units of the French army had to evacuate the beaches and the port of Dunkirk before the German offensive. In spite of the bombings and the cornered by the German military, they were able to rescue more than 338,000 men. José Alberto Pina has tried to reflect the most dramatic moments of this operation. The composition is divided into small sections. It begins with "The Prologue" where the main theme of Dunkirk appears, followed by "The mole, the beach", where the long wait was taking over the soldiers. In "The bombers" you can hear how little by little these planes were getting closer to take a nose-dive and destroy the lives of the soldiers. "The Dunkirk Spirit" is a term in the British culture that refers to the solidarity of the British people as they played a fundamental role, using small boats to get close to the shore and help with the transfer of soldiers. "The Failed Evacuation" is related to how the soldiers try to survive while the ships are being bombed. Finally, the bombers end up sinking without the possibility of surviving. In "The Hymn", the mood changes to a more joyful one. The final section, "The Evacuation", where the full orchestra along with the drums will put a special touch to the piece. Composed by José Alberto Pina.
